What:

Wyoming PLT, Wyoming Project WET, and Wyoming Project WILD are proud to sponsor a joint educational workshop presenting their award-winning curricula. You will go through fun example activities in each curriculum, learn how to implement them in your classroom and how to incorporate them into your curriculum.
